

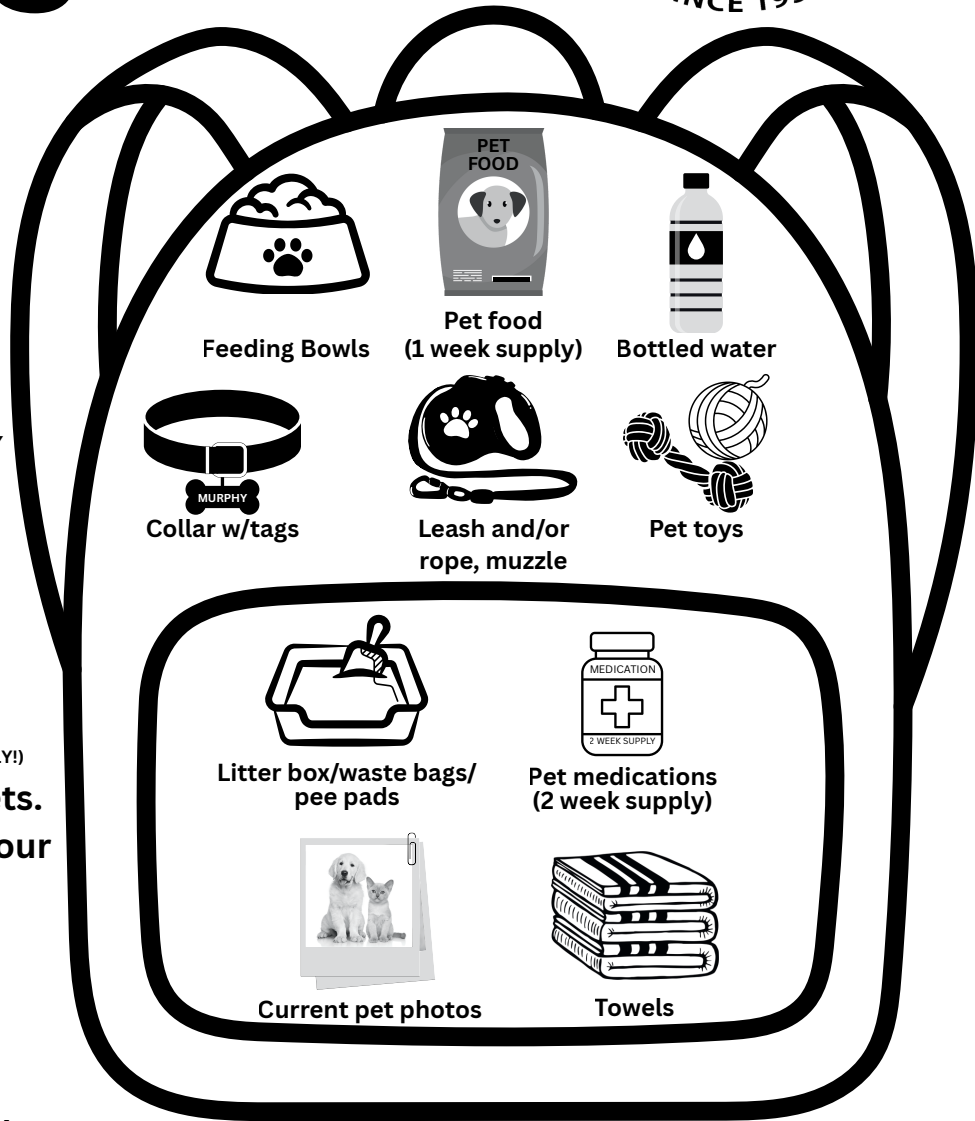


Disaster Plan for pets

Whether it's a disaster or an emergency, planning ahead will save valuable time-and keep pets safe

Prepare a "grab & go" bag

KEEP A BAG FILLED WITH AT LEAST A 5-DAY SUPPLY OF THESE ESSENTIAL PET SUPPLIES IN A READILY-ACCESSIBLE AREA.



Locate a shelter that accepts pets

(ALL BREVARD COUNTY HURRICANE SHELTERS ARE PET FRIENDLY!)

Not all evacuation shelters accept pets. Research shelters now, keep info in your pets go bag.



Find a pet-friendly hotel

Keep a list of at least three pet-friendly hotels outside your immediate area in your pets go-bag.



Reach out to friends

Who will shelter your pets in an emergency? Make arrangements ahead of time.



Pet Kennels and bedding

Familiar bedding helps reduce pets' stress, while a carrier or kennel protects them from noise, strangers, and from fleeing.
